

At ISI, you can choose a course or elective class from a wide variety of options according to your study period and purposes.



## Long-Term Course

This course is for those who have obtained a student visa with the intention of studying from 1 year and 3 months to a maximum of 2 years.

## Short-Term Standard Course

This Course is a 2 weeks minimum course for those who desire to study Japanese but plan to enter Japan with a visa other than a student visa. Available in all campuses.

## Exclusive Class

### Top University Preparation Class (Takadanobaba Campus only)






